City of Cambridge SC 2013 Summer Open Rules & Information

- 1. The competition will be held under ASA Law and Technical Rules
- 2. All events will be Heat Declared Winners (HDW). There will be no Finals. Electronic Timing will be used.
- 3. Cards will not be provided: a secondary registration system will be in operation.
- 4. Swimmers must sign in before the start of the warm-up for each session for each event in which they wish to take part. A swimmer who is late to sign in may be placed in an unoccupied lane at the discretion of the meet administrator, but this is not guaranteed.
- 5. Swimmers must not be signed in unless they are present.
- 6. All withdrawals after sign-in must be notified to the meet administrator as soon as possible, any un-notified withdrawals will be subject to a £10 fine, which must be paid prior to the competitor resuming participation in the meet.
- 7. Any competitor that withdraws on medical grounds will not be able to participate in any events for the remainder of that session.
- 8. Heat lists will be posted on poolside.
- 9. It is the responsibility of swimmers to check the heat lists and be at the marshalling area on time for their event, as instructed by the announcer.
- 10. "One start" rule will apply. Over the top starts will be used.
- 11. Entry Fee will be £4.50 per event. Fees should be enclosed with Individual Entry Forms and with Club Entry Summary Forms.
- 12. Entries will be on a first come first served basis with the final date for entries and payment receipt being Tuesday 4th June 2013. .
- 13. Entrants must be ASA Registered, belong to an affiliated club, and enter in the name of one club only. Ages on day.
- 14. Club entries for more than 3 swimmers must be submitted electronically. Sportsys entry files will be available on the club website at www.cocsc.org.uk or by email from swimmers@cocsc.org.uk.
- 15. Individual entry forms must have been correctly submitted and received by the promoter before the specified closing date. All individual and electronic entries **must** include a time and times entered faster than shown in the table on the entry form will be rejected.
- 16. Awards for the top 3 in each age group i.e. 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15+.
- 17. Coaches Passes are available at £10.00 each, which includes lunch and a programme. There will be a maximum of 3 coaches passes available per club. Results will be available for download from our website. Results will also be uploaded to the ASA rankings database. Coach Passes **CANNOT** be purchased on the day of the meet. Passes can only be obtained by completing an application form and submitting it as stated on the form. Passes must be displayed at all times. Poolside assistants must have undertaken a CRB Check and this number should be submitted on the form.
- 18. The promoters reserve the right to pre-seed any or all of the events to facilitate the smooth running of the meet.
- 19. Session start times are given in the programme of events. Competitors will not be allowed poolside until 8.15am.
- 20. An admission charge will be made for Spectators (£5 per day/£2 per session OAP's and under 10's free of charge). Programmes (£3) will be available on the day. Results Sheets will be displayed poolside and in the spectators' gallery and will be available to download from our website. Free parking is available on local streets on Sundays such as Harvey, St Pauls and Gresham Road which are less than five minutes walk from the pool. The adjacent Queen Ann Car Park costs £1 per hour on Sunday.
- 21. For Health and Safety reasons only small rucksack bags will be allowed poolside. Lockers are available with a £1 coin (refundable) Pool staff will remove any large obtrusive bags.
- 22. Any person wishing to take pictures by any means must register at the entry desk in accordance with ASA guidelines and recommendations.
- 23. No person will be allowed on poolside without a pass.
- 24. There will be no glass items allowed on poolside.
- 25. The Promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor, participant, coach or spectator.
- 26. Anything not covered in the above information and rules will be at the discretion of the Promoter. The Promoter's decision relating to the interpretation of these rules will be final.

Disability Swimming Conditions

The conditions outlined above shall apply to the Disability Swimming events except where varied by any of the following conditions.

Eligibility

- 1. Swimmers with S1- S15 classifications will be accepted.
- 2. All swimmers must have an internationally authorised classification and a Functional Ability Card (FAC), a copy of which must be submitted with their entry. This FAC must also be presented to the referee **before** the start of each session in which the competitor is entered.
- 3. An FAC can be obtained via an application to the FAC co-ordinator, who can be contacted via British Swimming.
- 4. Competitors must be registered members of the ASA.
- 5. The meet does not have disability consideration times, however the organisers reserve the right to reject swimmers after the closing date if demand exceeds the time available in the galas.

Personal Care Attendants

- 1. Personal care attendants will be permitted for swimmers in all disability classes.
- 2. A swimmer may have both a coach and a personal care attendant present.

Competition Format

- 1. The competition format will be based on disability inclusion within the able-bodied programme. Swimmers will be integrated on a time-banded basis in all events.
- 2. Positions will be determined by each swimmer's times relative to the world record in their own classification.
- 3. Disability swimmers will be included but not placed within the results for the appropriate age group in the able-bodied competition unless their entry times meet the qualifying times for the able-bodied competition. They will also be included in the Multi Disability results and placed within those results according to their equivalent times.
- 4. Winners of all events will be heat declared.
- 5. Competition to be run under IPC Swimming swim rules.
- 6. An official who holds the qualification of ASA Disability Official will act as a technical advisor in each of the sessions where disability athletes are entered, if available.

Medals

- 1. Medals shall be awarded on a multi-disability basis to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each event. Medals shall be awarded following the posting of the results after the relevant event has taken place.
- 2. Placing shall be determined by achieving a time better than or closest to, the equivalent World record relevant to their own classification.
