- 1. All members to be given a copy of club rules upon joining the Club, which shall be strictly adhered to
- 2. All new members are required to complete a membership form
- 3. All existing members are required to annually complete a membership update form
- 4. Members are responsible for paying their fees monthly as they fall due, either by Bankers Orders (amended as and when necessary) or, by alternative means in agreement with the Clubs Hon. Treasurer
- 5. Members wishing to leave the Club should tender their resignation in writing to the Membership Secretary and cancel their Bankers Order where appropriate
- 6. Cambridge Parkside Pools are the Club's headquarters and information regarding Club activities, competitions and galas will be available there
- 7. All swimmers, divers and team members are expected to wear Team clothing, tee shirts and hats (if worn) at all galas, competitions and presentations when representing the Club
- 8. Any member in possession of any Club trophy must inform the Trophy Steward immediately of any, loss, damage incurred or repair considered necessary explaining the circumstances relevant in writing
- 9. All members for their own safety are to wear seats belts on any transport provide by the Club when travelling to competitions, galas or Club organised events. Non-members may travel on transport provided if seats are available, for a nominal charge
- 10. Club members should not be involved in any conduct or activity that may harm or bring into disrepute the name or reputation of the Club. Any serious misbehaviour by a Club member during Club time shall be reported to, and then considered by the Executive Committee or its representatives and appropriate action taken
- 11. All Club coaches, teachers, poolside helpers and persons involved with Club members during any Club activity shall complete an ASA Child Protection Form, available from the Club's Hon Secretary
- 12. Any member who has a diagnosed medical condition or who is on prescribed medication must notify their Coach or teacher prior to training or competing in an event. Asthma sufferers are required to complete an ASA form available from the Membership Secretary
- 13. All members are required to abide by the ASA's 'Code of Ethics'
- 14. Any member who should have a complaint shall put this in writing to the Hon. Secretary whom shall answer in writing after discussion by the Executive Committee
- 15. Where competitions have an entry criteria, all Club members are expected to complete the criteria from known achieved times. No Club official will sign for Entry times that cannot be validated
- 16. The Club's constitution will be displayed at Cambridge Parkside Pools

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
