

CoCSC: Team event selection criteria

- For all selected team events the coaches will endeavour to select and build their strongest team from all the Club's registered swimmers across the different age groups.
- To ensure the club is represented by its strongest team, selection will generally be based on the availability of swimmers with the quickest times, although this may not always be the case as coaches have to consider other factors when building a strong team across a range of different individual events and relays.
- Team selection will be made from all squads within the club including, but not limited to, performance squads, senior squad, University squad and Masters squad.
- As CoCSC has formal links with Royston Swimming Club as part of the Swim 21 pathway of progression, team selection may also include those Royston swimmers who are dual registered with CoCSC and who the coaches feel are suitable to compete.
- For certain events, such as M11 or Arena League, all participating swimmers must be registered members of CoCSC by a specified date and the club has to provide evidence of this at prior to the start of the competition. As a result, swimmers who join the club after the club list has been submitted will not be eligible to compete.
- The coaches' decision on all selections is final.
- For certain League events, where it is feasible the Club may consider putting forward two teams to give a greater number of swimmers the opportunity to participate and represent the Club.
- Any swimmer who wishes to understand more about why they have or have not been selected is welcome to talk to their coach.
